career clerking for former U.S. Rep. Diane E. Watson (then State Senator), in California, which led to positions as

Bill Drafter/ Committee Counsel to the Maryland legislature and Caseworker (State Department/ INS) for then U.S. Sen. Barbara A. Mikulski. Focusing on civil integration and community development, she clerked for Bryan, Jupiter, Lewis & Blanson, in Louisiana and Office of BMW Kahari in Zimbabwe, before joining the then civil litigation practice of Judge Mark Scurti. Focusing on refugee protection and immigration, Ms. Kong-Sivert then served as Director of Legal Services for


IMMIGRATION LAW

Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Services, and of the Refugee Program for Amnesty International USA. She headed the asylum and litigation sections of the immigration department at Becker, Hadeed, Kellogg & Berry.
