To bid on an item, <u>write **BOTH** your name and bidder number</u> on the line next to the amount you want to bid. If you want two spaces for an event, please write your bid number on two separate lines on the bid sheet, one per each person attending.

The highest bidder(s) wins. The next highest bidder may outbid the last bidder in a price category. For example, if six people bid \$30.00 on an event intended for six people and the seventh person bids \$40.00, the last person in the \$30.00 category loses the bid. Members of the *FUUN*d Committee will be available each auction morning to answer your bidding questions.

**Buy It Now:** The "Buy it Now" (maximum bid) guarantees you seats at the event. When the "Buy it Now" event category is full, the bidding for that event ends. Not every item has a "Buy it Now" price.
