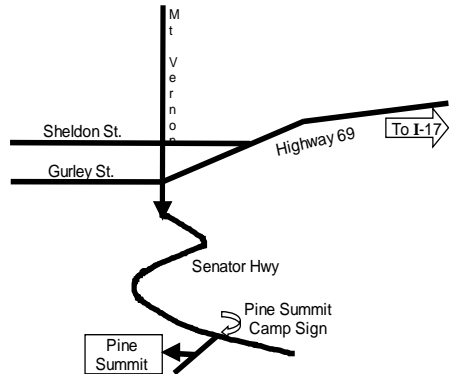

## **What to Bring:**

- Bedding – Pillow, sleeping bag, mattress cover, sheet, blanket, ear plugs
- Towels, washcloths, bar soap, shampoo and other toiletries
- Comfortable shoes for gym and hikes
- Flashlights and camera
- Identifiable mug for hot beverages
- Marshmallow roasting sticks
- Special snacks and beverages that you may want
- Toys for young children in childcare
- Games, books and puzzles for sharing
- Poems, stories, skits, props and other items for the Un-talent show
- Musical instruments, yoga mats, t-shirts and other items needed for workshops



**Directions (Takes approx. 2 hours):** Drive North on I-17, for ~60 miles, take Cordes Junction/Prescott exit to West Highway 69 for ~36 miles. As you enter Prescott, continue onto Gurley St, then turn Left (South) at Mt Vernon St. If you reach Jack in the Box, you've gone too far. Mt Vernon St becomes the Senator Highway. Travel about 7 miles, until the blacktop ends. Continue on the gravel road for approximately 100 yards. Turn right at the Pine Summit sign then turn right again in ¼ mile into the Camp.
