will present a two-person panel on transgender identity. Presenters include Dr. Veenod Chulani and Dr. Mischa Peck.

Veenod Chulani, MD, MSED, FSAHM, CEDS, leads Phoenix Children's Adolescent Medicine Program, and is one of only a handful of specialists in Arizona. Dr. Chulani also specializes in working with gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender (GLBT) youth, including those seeking cross gender hormonal therapies. Dr. Chulani is Section Chief of Adolescent Medicine at Phoenix Children's Hospital.

Dr. Mischa Peck, a transgender woman, is a counselor and therapist. She writes, "As you can imagine, my personal journey has taught me much about resilience—just think about the many life changes in this process. For more than 40 years, I lived my life as a male-identified. I experienced life and studied academically much about men and masculinity—including trying and trying and trying to figure out where I fit. Through this path, I found myself: I am Mischa."






