Quilts from the Migrant Quilt Project

Part of a collection of quilts made over the last 16 years by quilters across the U.S. to memorialize migrants who have died in the "Tucson Sector" of Arizona. Each quilt includes the names of all those whose remains have been found—or the word "desconocido/a" meaning "unknown"—and items of clothing and other textiles found in layups, or resting places.
