


















8. How many children under the age of 18 are there in your family? If multiple adult family members in the same household are completing this survey, please choose one family member to respond to this question.







10. Which of the following income categories best describes your total annual household income? If multiple adult family members in the same household are completing this survey, please choose one family member to respond to this question









Our Ministry







17. Which of the following professional skills and qualifications do you think are very important for the search committee to consider when screening ministerial candidates? Please mark no more than three.








19. Which of the professional skills and qualifications listed in Question 17 do you believe is the LEAST IMPORTANT in choosing a new minister?





