Position Title: Interim Part-time Music Coordinator

Position Summary: The Interim Music Coordinator is responsible for planning and supervising the congregation's music program.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Working in concert with the Senior Minister, oversee the volunteer leadership of the congregation's vocal/instrumental groups and other music-related programming
- 2. Recruit and supervise talented (professional and non-professional) musicians and other volunteers to participate in a variety of capacities within the music ministries program
- 3. Serve as liaison to the Senior Minister for music volunteers and groups and part-time staff
- 4. Oversee the administrative tasks of song lyrics, copyright in slides, copyright reporting, sheet music and charts
- 5. Manage a team working with the music leaders on Sundays so that people know what is happening week-by-week and stay connected and informed about the process
- 6. Manage the budget for the music program
- 7. Oversee the maintenance of VUU's musical instruments and the contents of the music library
- 8. Coordinate with the tech team for audio-visual components
- 9. Collaborate with congregation stakeholders to create a music program vision and mission
